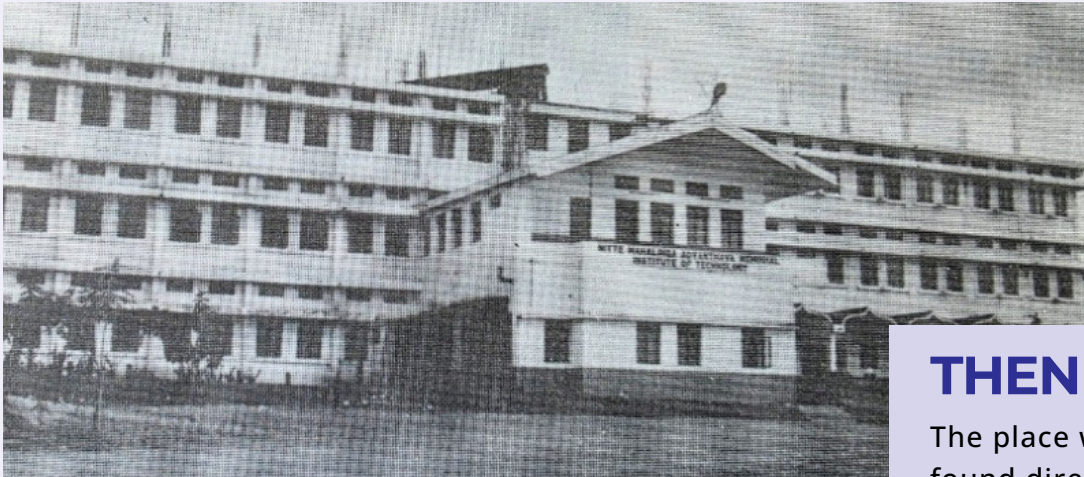

Celebrations concluded at 5:30 PM, leaving everyone with cherished memories and a lingering question:

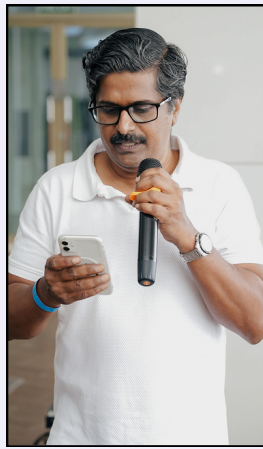
